**Application Submission Requirements**

Students do not need prior formal training in art or animation to apply to this program. All artwork should be original and created by the artist themselves. Students may submit something they created while in a class environment or on their own. However, we do request that each student submit the following work with their application.

1. Artist statement
  - Describe who you are, as an artist, in no more than 150 words.
2. Statement of Goals
  - Why are you interested in the animation, film, TV and/or game industry
  - What do you want to do with your skills moving forward? Is it to work at a studio or company, or do you want to do something else with your art?

3. Submit one or more of the following:

- Short animation: this can be any kind of animation (hand-drawn, stop motion, 3D, digital, etc.) and be any subject matter. The animation must be at least 10 seconds long. This does not have to be something newly created for this application, however the piece you are submitting must have been completed after May 2016.
- Three character designs: original works created by the artist applying for the class and each design must be a different character.
- Free form art: any piece of art that you feel expresses who you are as an artist in any form you choose (portrait, background, abstract, cartoon, comic, etc.).

4. Submission guidelines

All submissions must follow the guidelines given below. Your artwork must be original and from your own experiences and imagination. We want to see artwork that reflects the content and distinctive style of your work.

- Statement
  - Artist statement and goals in one document, either Word doc or PDF
  - File name: Last Name\_First Name\_FSTSArtStatements.doc or pdf
- Artwork
  - Animation (save as .mov)
