POSITION PURPOSE:

The role of the Audio Visual (AV) Event Technician is to take direction from the Manager of AV in supporting the Museum's internal and rental events. The role will also provide technical support for significant components of The Walt Disney Museum's AV systems as well as providing a smooth and stable infrastructure. The position may also assist the AV team carry out planned preventative maintenance, reactive repairs and minor installation work in relation to the Audio Visual systems within the museum.

ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide a full range of AV technical support.
- Set up of AV equipment for daily and special events.
- Assisting with minor AV installations, repairs work, and maintenance tasks.
- Present a professional image to visitors, and ensure excellence in customer service.
- Provide general site services including the housekeeping of work areas.
- Ensure a safe & healthy working environment, and compliance with all policies and procedures.
