# How to Draw a Dog

STEP I: Start by drawing an oval. This oval will form the cheeks of the dog we are creating. You can make the oval as flat or as round as you'd like to give your dog just the right amount of personality and cuteness.

STEP 2: Add a rounded box on top of the oval to form the head of the dog. Just like the cheeks, you can play with the size and proportions to make your dog unique.

STEP 3: Add two rounded triangles on top of the head shape for ears. Add a circle to form the muzzle.


STEP 4: Now we can get creative. Add eyes, a nose, and a mouth. Have fun! Any changes or additions will give your dog character. Play with eye size and shapes. Make the nose big or small. Your dog can be smiling or frowning, mouth open or closed.


STEP 5: Remove all unnecessary overlapping lines and add color to let your original design shine. Add spots or a collar if desired.
