EXHIBITION OVERVIEW



Considered one of the finest and most influential Disney films, *The Jungle Book* (1967) is the last animated film that Walt Disney personally produced with his signature vision and warmth. This special exhibition, guest curated by acclaimed animator and Disney Legend Andreas Deja, explores the complexities of the film's development, production, and release.

EXHIBITION HIGHLIGHTS



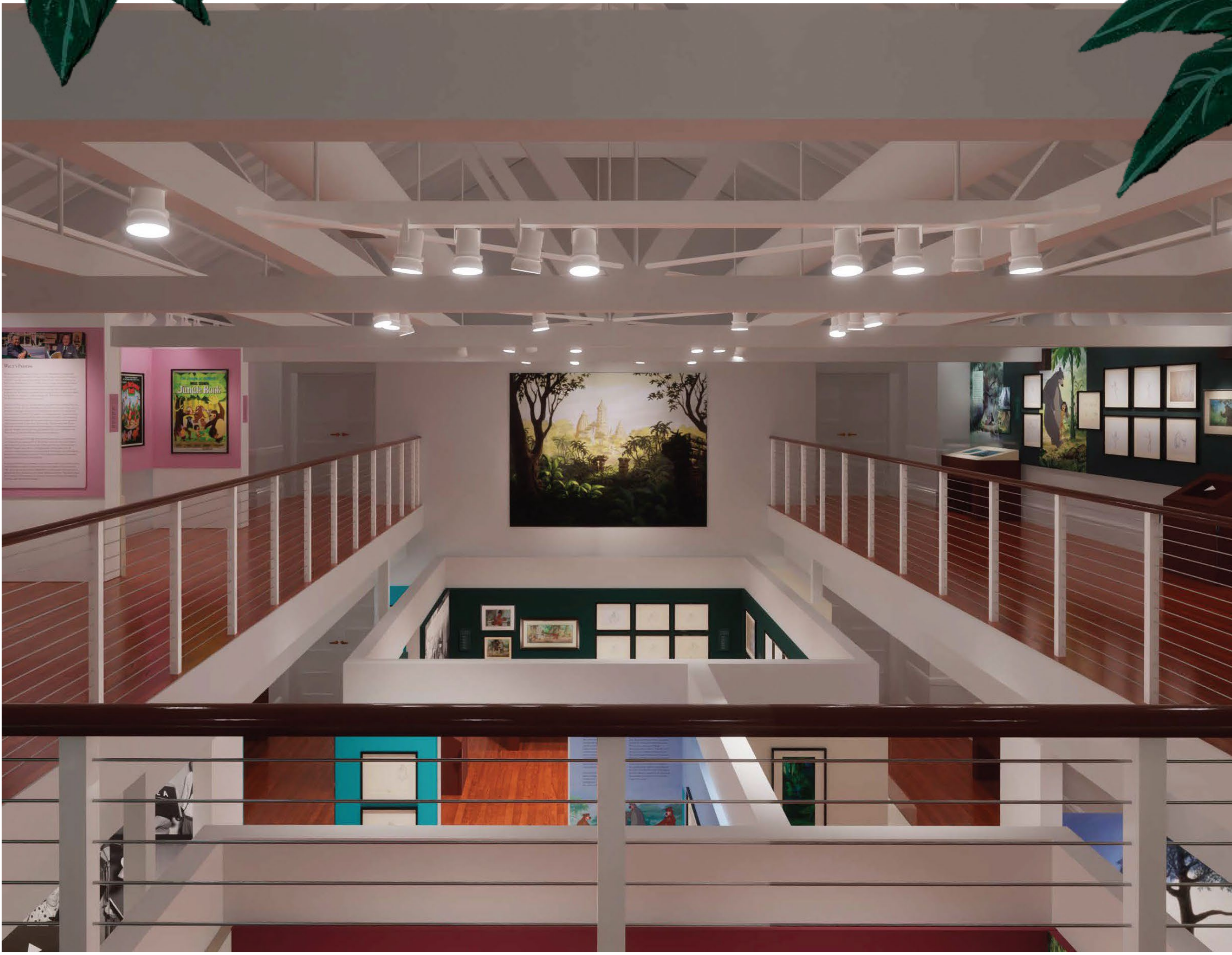
Guests will learn about:

- The original Rudyard Kipling *Jungle Book* stories
- The unique characters in the film and their voice-actor counterparts
- The rich original artwork for the film and use of new animation techniques
- Original songs by the Sherman brothers and Terry Gilkyson
- The impact of Walt Disney's passing on The Walt Disney Studios
- The everlasting legacy of the film throughout the world

ASSET BREAKDOWN

- The exhibition consists of about 542 linear feet (wall space)
- 221 2D original objects, including animation drawings, cel-set ups, story sketches, concept art, background art, and more
- 46 3D objects, including merchandise from the 1960s through the 90s
- 106 2D reproductions of artwork, final frames from the film, photographs, and more
- 7 video monitors, 3 projections, and 4 interactive monitors, featuring film clips, original interviews from Disney animators, interviews from artists and animators inspired by the film, and more
- **18 crates of material**

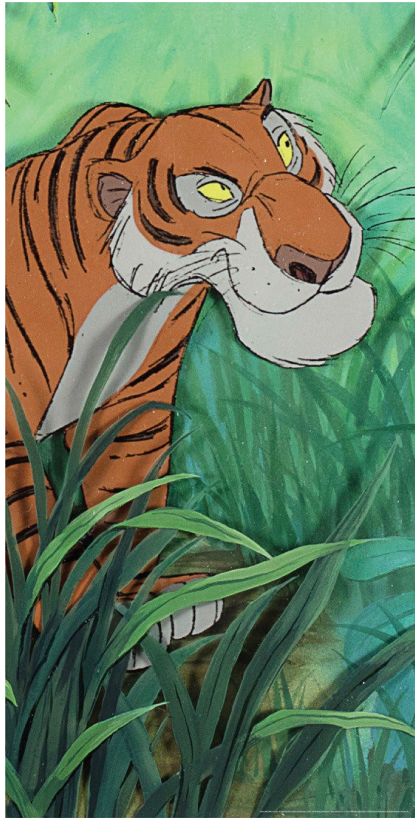

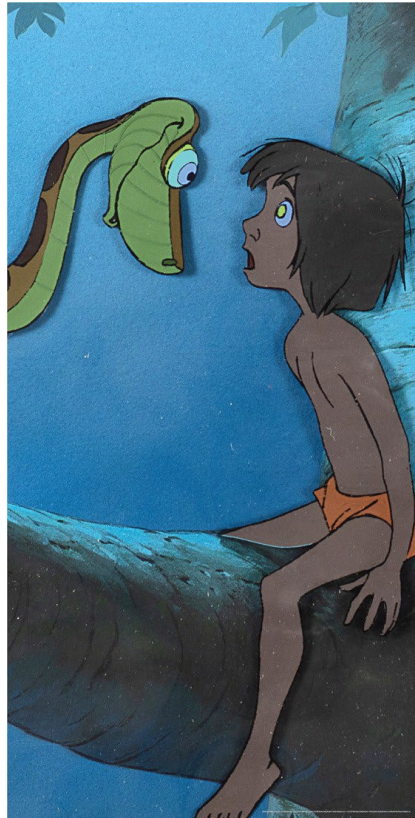
