



Inspired by the recent book of the same name written by Academy Award®-winning director and Pixar Chief Creative Officer Pete Docter and Disney historian and author Don Peri, this exhibition spotlights the legendary directors whose creative talent and innovations made Walt Disney's animated films possible from the 1920s through the 1970s.





## Exhibition Details:

- Cost: \$75,000, which includes rental fee and crating expenses; does not include shipping and courier expenses
- Duration: Available for a maximum of 6 months
- Size: Approximately 200 linear feet (wall space); can be reduced or expanded depending on borrower's requirements
- Asset breakdown:
  - About 30 2D objects
  - 2 3D objects
  - About 45 physical printed graphics
  - Digital graphic files: photo murals, design elements, and labels
  - 10 digital AV files: animated short/feature film clips, a Hyperion Studio tour, and an exclusive panel discussion from D23: The Ultimate Disney Fan Event (2024)
  - 8 crates of materials
