## Exhibition Details:

- Cost: \$175,000, which includes rental fee and crating expenses; does not include shipping and courier expenses
  - Duration: Available for a maximum of 6 months
  - Size: Approximately 542 linear feet (wall space); can be reduced or expanded depending on borrower's requirements
  - Asset breakdown:
    - About 220 2D objects
    - About 45 3D objects
    - 23 physical graphics: text panels and photos
    - Digital graphic files: text panels, photos, design elements, and labels
    - 12 digital AV files: film clips, interviews, interactive activities
    - 18 crates of material
